**1. Development of Sericulture at Saphai Village.**

A convergence effort was initiated by the District Basin Development Unit, WJHD in collaboration with the Sericulture Department, WJHD and Bellefonte Community College for the development of Eri farmers of Saphai Village. The BDU proposed for the setting up of a Training cum Spinning center in the Village. Before initiating the proposal, an Awareness cum-Training Programme on Eri Spinning was organized for the farmers of the Village.

**2. Establishment of Fish Sanctuary at Syntu Kpiar**

A convergence effort was also initiated between the BDU, Office of the Superintendent of Fisheries Jowai, BDO Thadlaskein and the Jaintia Fishing & Environment Society, Jowai for the establishment of the Sanctuary on the water pool already created by the Soil & Water Conservation Department.

### **Objective:**

- ❖ To conserve the Indigenous and Endemic species
- ❖ To create an un-disturbed breeding ground for Mahaseers
- ❖ To promote and boost tourism.
- ❖ To enhance the livelihood promotion within the area.
- ❖ To create proper sanitation facilities.
- ❖ Gap funding by MBDA has been sanctioned and works is still in progress.

### **3. Development of Piggery at Nartiang.**

The objective of the program is to ensure self sufficiency in meat demand. The success of the programme would be replicated in other areas as well. A model for convergence is being worked out between BDU and AH & Veterinary Department. The BDU has organized Awareness cum Interactive Session with the Partners from the Village on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2013. Till date 13 partners have been sent by MIE for training at SIRD, Nongsder.

#### **4. Reviving the Pottery of Larnai Village.**

Seven partners have been sent for training on Poultry Farming to RRTC Umran, from 24<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> Feb, 2014. Two partners were sent to Umsalait CLF for training cum awareness programme on poultry farming. And three of them attended a one day Training Needs Assessment Programme on 14<sup>th</sup>, December, 2013 at SIRD Nongsder. Three partners were send for exposure visit to NIRD Hyderabad and 2 partners were sent to EDI, Gujarat, 3 partners were sent to Vocational Training Centre, Kyrdem Kulai on Dairy Farming and nine partners have been sent for training to RRTC Umran for Beekeeping.

The Livelihood Mapping exercised of Amlarem Block was conducted on 24<sup>th</sup> June to 1<sup>st</sup>. July. 2013 in five villages (Kudengthymmai, Thangbuli, Umladkhur, Pamtbuh, and Kudengrim) on 28<sup>th</sup>. Aug to 6<sup>th</sup>. Sept. 2013 in fourteen villages (Shnongpdeng, Bakur, Hawai Bhoi, Lamin, Samanong, Pdengshakap, Amlari rim, Jong-u-chen, Khliehamkshar, Amsohmahaleng, Trangblang, Syndai, Mupyut, Amtasam), with an objective of understanding the major livelihood activities being undertaken by the people in the block, identify gaps in the existing activity if any and suggest interventions as well as to identify any other potential livelihood activities that could be undertaken in the villages under the Block. The livelihood mapping survey/conducted revealed with two livelihood activities which are relevant to the Block are orange cultivation and Broom grass cultivation.

This exercised helps in identifying and understanding the various livelihood activities undertaken by the people at the grass root level. It also helps us to build a strong rapport with the

people. The exercise was conducted with the help of Shri. Wilhelmos Shylla, Rolin Shadap and. Pynshngain Rymmai, (Interns MBDA), Smt. Justina Shylla, (Programme Associate) and Smt. Dajan Khonglah, (ERP Amlarem EFC). The entire expenditure of the exercise was borne by the ‘The livelihood School’.

## **TRAINING CUM EXPOSURE VISIT FOR 7 PARTNERS TO CENTRAL VILLAGE POTTERY INSTITUTE, KHANAPUR, KARNATAKA**

It was on the 12<sup>th</sup> September 2014 that the team from District Basin Development Unit, West Jaintia Hills District which constitutes of 7 Artisan registered under Thadlaskein EFC undergoing training at the Central Village Pottery. The partners were guide by one Programme Associate Shri. Olari Nongtdu.

During the Training programme the Partner were introduced to different type of clays used in the making of pot clay namely Black clay, Shadow Clay and Tank Clay. A mixture of these three forms the clay used for making pot. These 3 types of clay are mix in the ratio of 5:3:2 which are then mix in the Blenger which is in the form of a tank. Before the mixture of these 3 types of clay proper filtration should be done by the use of mesh jar so that a powdery nature is achieved for the mixture process. Later on we were introduced to the 4 section of trainings namely Wheel Section, Bonsai Section, Wheel ware Section (Used of China Clay) and Firing section.

### **Benefits:**

The trainees have been blessed with the opportunity acquired on the Capacity building for Pottery with the use of the Electric Wheel and the different method taught to which are not known to us .It has enlightened them to work hard and it has benefited a lot to learned the different style and design to make pots using the wheel, Bonsai and Flower pot.
