			<p>a) We request that in place of previous experience in the PAT sector, previous experience in the Forestry Sector should be considered as it is much more relevant to this assignment.</p> <p>b) The Forestry Carbon Sequestration market has two possible instruments: regulatory including CDM and voluntary apart from Jurisdictional REDD+. We have experience in developing India's first and only 4 Jurisdictional REDD+ projects with MoEFCC, 10 CDM projects etc. We have helped MoEFCC develop the National REDD+ Policy and MRV system and are part of the Oslo REDD+ Exchange. We have further carried out a similar feasibility study for 5 states. We request you to kindly consider the same in scoring criteria.</p> <p>c) We also have experience in trading Carbon credits in the regulatory and voluntary markets. PAT and REC are specific to energy and industry, which is not very relevant to forestry sector.
