- a. Precise evaluation and documentation of Living root bridge sites and underlying context through direct engagement with indigenous communities
- b. Developing appropriate site conservation and development plans with focus on traditional horticultural knowledge and vernacular construction skills
- c. Coordination with stakeholders to implement sustainable development plans
